Harry Potter Touches the Stern Center

Williston, VT – For her Grad Challenge project, CVU senior and Williston resident, Sophia Trigg established a CVU Chapter of the International Harry Potter Alliance which is dedicated to combating social injustices of all stripes including poverty, hunger, illness, and illiteracy. The International HPA has tackled injustices on a grand scale such as their raising \$110,000 to charter three planes full of relief supplies for Haiti. During the month of March the HPA focused on an international book drive to support local agencies around the globe. Ms. Trigg chose to donate books to the Stern Center for Language and Learning, a nonprofit center dedicated to helping all learners of all ages and types reach their full potential. This set of books will enhance the Stern Center's Wallman Library in both the Williston and White River Junction sites, making more literature available to hundreds of learners each year.
