### Research (a sampling)

#### Instruction

- Students showed significant gains in word identification, spelling, fundamental literacy, sound/symbol, sight word efficiency, phonemic decoding, reading
- 100% of responding parents would recommend to others

#### **BUILDING BLOCKS**

- 100% of educators showed significant gains in knowledge of how to teach language literacy

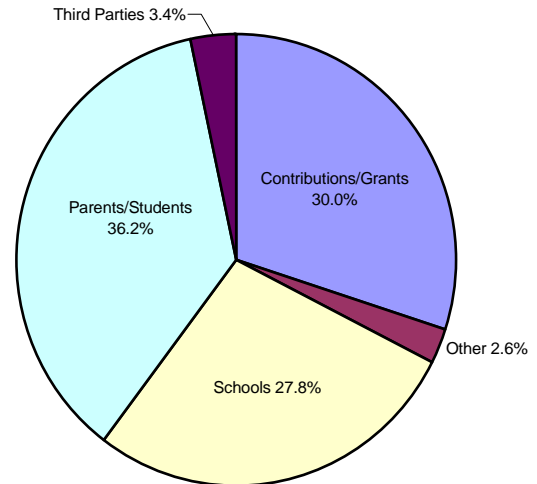
#### **TIME for Teachers**

- Significant gains in teacher knowledge; all sites; all formats

#### **Social Skills Classes/Groups**

- 100% of responding parents stated this program has helped their children
- 100% would recommend to others
